You assume the persona of a young pilot who has recently been working as first mate aboard the *Scarab*, a well-weathered merchant ship with a retired Academy officer named Geof Kane at its helm. Kane knows that running supplies, food and equipment is

more appealing than following the rigid rules set by the top brass in the Academy.... and more profitable.

The last run took the crew to Sheol, a deep space science station that was in need of some supplies. Upon arriving, the captain had a gut feeling that something wasn't right, either from paranoia or intuition developed by years of experience, but mainly because of a series of attacks on friendly merchant ships travelling to and from the base.
